2008 G37; INTERMITTENT/SHORT DURATION SMALL RPM INCREASE DURING BRAKING

APPLIED VEHICLE: 2008 G37 (CV36) with Automatic Transmission ONLY

APPLIED DATE: Built before December 6, 2007

APPLIED VIN: Built before JNKCV64E(*)8M 115669

IF YOU CONFIRM:

The engine intermittently experiences a small RPM increase (less than 500 RPM) for a short duration during braking.

ACTIONS:

- 1. Refer to Step 2 in the Service Procedure to confirm this bulletin applies to the vehicle you are working on.
- If this bulletin applies; reprogram the ECM.

CLAIMS INFORMATION

Submit a Primary Failed Part (PP) line claim using the following claims coding:

Reprogram ECM per TSB	(1)	DE98AA (2)	ZE	32	0.6 hrs (2)

- (1) Reference the Repair Order and use the current ECM P/N written down in Step 2 as the PFP.
- (2) FRT allows adequate time to access DTC codes and reprogram ECM. No other diagnostic procedures subsequently required – do NOT claim any Diagnostic Op Codes with this claim.
